Why is an interview needed?

an excellent opportunity to set yourself apart from other applicants. It allows you to show your interest in the desired study program, and outline precisely why you are the right candidate. The 3 parts of the interview

University application interviews usually start with questions about your study motivation and expectations. This can be followed by a presentation on a previously set task. The last part will be about your personal questions.

What will you be asked? (samples)

Why do you want to study the desired program / subject? How long have you been interested in the subject? What do you particularly like about the desired study program and why? Why did you decide for this university? What do the universities values mean to you personally? What career plans do you have? What practical experience have you gained so far in relation to the program? What (extracurricular) activities provide evidence of your motivation?

The key to success: How to prepare for the interview

- 1. Be well informed about the university and the study program you applied to.
- 2. Prepare your presentation properly.
- 3. Think about 2-3 questions you would like to ask the interviewers.



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
