Complete your studies with the Master's thesis at MBS or earn an additional finance related degree from a renowned partner university by adding a second semester abroad at e.g. Bond University (Financial Management, MFM), FIU (Finance, MSc), Regent's University (Finance, MSc) or Skema Business School (Corporate Financial Management, MSc).

### **Study Options**

- Single Degree: ca. 18 months (3 semesters) + Master's thesis, incl. semester abroad, internship or start-up project, Degree: Master of Arts
- **Dual Degree:** ca. 24 months (4 semesters) + Master's thesis, incl. two semesters abroad and (optional) internship, Degree: Master of Arts + Master of Science or MBA

### **Study Fees**

- Enrollment fee: EUR 690 (EU/EFTA), (for international students EUR 1,490)
- Pre-Master: EUR 6,500
- Master's program: EUR 24,900, payable in 3 equal installments;
- **Dual Degree:** fees upon request.

#### **Study Start**

- Pre-Master: May (online)
- Master's program: September (new from 2024)

#### **Scholarships**

Munich Business School offers a limited number of partial scholarships to outstanding candidates. The scholarships amount up to EUR 4,000 of the overall tuition fee. In order to apply for one of these limited scholarships, you usually have to include a personal statement and other supporting documents when applying for the program.

- MBS Explorer Scholarship: The MBS Explorer Scholarship is aimed at comitted future students and those who do not have the financial means to afford private studies.
- MBS Best Scholarship: The MBS Best Scholarship is aimed at particularly high-performing and committed future students.
