



VISA PROCESS

DURATION OF VISA PROCESS: 3–4 MONTHS

1. Make an appointment at the German Embassy

Make an appointment at the German Embassy as soon as you have your acceptance documents.
Waiting time: Usually 4 weeks or longer in peak times (June – August).

Acceptance Documents from MBS:

- Signed Study Contract
- Visa Invitation Letter
- Acceptance Letter



Duration: 2 – 4 weeks (MBS is not able to speed up this process)

2. Appointment at the German Embassy & Blocked Account

You need a blocked account ("Sperrkonto") from a German bank in order to receive your visa. The German embassy should give you information on the day of your appointment.

MBS cooperates with Fintiba, where you can open your blocked account online within a few hours:

Don't wait too long otherwise you won't receive your visa on time.



Duration: 3 – 4 weeks (MBS is not able to speed up this process)

3. Visa application will be sent to Munich

German embassy will send your visa to the Alien Registration Office in Munich.



Duration: 3 – 4 weeks (MBS is not able to speed up this process)

4. Pick up your visa

Visa can be picked up at the embassy.

Student should receive the visa at least a month prior to the start of their studies.
