What is the Pre-Bachelor Study Program?

It is a compact preparation that acts as a bridge from high school to the Bachelor's program at Munich Business School (MBS). In one semester, from September to December, you will gain basic business knowledge as well as study skills. The Mathematics course provides you with the necessary level to succeed in the Bachelor's program. You will prepare for the Duolingo test and take a German language course for absolute beginners, which helps you to quickly integrate into German daily life. The program is completed by a Munich Outreach Project and excursion activities.

What's next?

After successful completion of the Pre-Bachelor Study Program, you get direct entry into the Bachelor International Business, which starts in February. By combining the Pre-Bachelor Study Program and the Bachelor International Business, you obtain a first class international Bachelor's degree in four years.

Sneak peek – the Bachelor International Business

The Bachelor's at MBS lays the perfect foundation for an international business career. You choose concentrations, e.g. Marketing and Sales, Innovation Management, Supply Chain Management. Additionally, you select an international focus with a second foreign language. A term abroad and three internships make the Bachelor's program an international business champion.

The application process consists of a written application and a personal interview. First application requirements are a graduation that entitles to higher education at a German university (e.g. Abitur, Fachabitur, IB Diploma, A-level) and advanced English language skills (min. level B2 according to CEFR).
